

**2019 Waislitz Global Citizen Award
Terms and Conditions**

1. The Promoter is Global Poverty Project, Inc d/b/a Global Citizen of 594 Broadway, Suite 207, NY NY 10012, United States of America (“Promoter”).
2. By entering the 2019 Waislitz Global Citizen Award (the “Competition”), entrants accept these Terms & Conditions of entry.
3. Entry to this Competition is open to entrants aged eighteen (18) years of age or older from anywhere in the world (“Entrant(s)”), excluding employees and their immediate families of the Promoter and its related companies.
4. To enter the Competition, Entrants must follow the instructions at <https://www.globalcitizen.org/en/programs/waislitz-award/>. Entries must be submitted between 12:00 PM EDT on April 12, 2019 and 11:59PM EDT on May 19, 2019. Entrants will be evaluated based on individual merit, including the following four (4) key areas:
 - a) Global citizenship - How does the Entrant embody and exemplify the values and practices of a Global Citizen?
 - b) Proof of concept - Does the Entrant have a strong proof of concept with at least 1-2 years of impact towards ending extreme poverty?
 - c) Disruption - Has the Entrant created measurable impact in an innovative manner that disrupts the systems that allow for extreme poverty to exist?
 - d) Scalability - How would the Prize enable/support the Entrant to scale or improve their work?
5. Three (3) prizes will be awarded for the Competition, consisting of a first prize of USD\$100,000 (the “First Prize”) and two semi-finalists each winning awards of USD\$50,000 (the “Global Citizen’s Choice” and the “Disruptor Semi-Finalist”) (each a “Prize”, awarded to a “Prize Winner” and collectively, the “Prize Winners”).
 - a) One (1) First Prize will be selected by the Waislitz Foundation based on the 4 criteria listed above.
 - b) One (1) “Global Citizen’s Choice” winner will be selected following a public online voting process on the www.globalcitizen.org platform by the Global Citizen community - individuals registered on the Global Citizen platform - during a five (5) day period. The final evaluation of the “Global Citizen’s Choice” semi-finalist will be done by the Waislitz Foundation taking into account the results of the public online voting process and the 4 criteria listed previously.

- c) One (1) Disruptor Semi-Finalist will be selected by the Waislitz Foundation based on the 4 criteria listed above for an Entrant who excels in disruption and innovation (criterion 4(c) listed above).
6. To be eligible to win a Prize, the Prize Winners must:
 - a) hold a valid passport, and be responsible for any requisite visas required to travel to New York City;
 - b) be able to attend the 2019 Waislitz Global Citizen award ceremony during the week of September 23, 2019 (exact date TBA). Attending the Global Citizen Festival in New York City on 28 September, 2019 is optional; and
 - c) agree to provide regular written updates to Promoter and the Waislitz Foundation on their use of the Prize.
7. In addition to the Prize, Promoter will pay for the following for each Prize Winner:
 - a) return economy airfares to New York City for each Prize Winner and a companion, with the flight originating from the Prize Winner's nearest capital city;
 - b) hotel accommodation in New York City for each Prize Winner and a companion for the period of one day immediately prior to date of the Waislitz Global Citizen award ceremony through 29 September 2019 (if Prize Winner opts to attend the Global Citizen Festival);
 - c) a per diem of USD\$100 per day for each full day that Prize Winner is in New York City to attend the Waislitz Global Citizen award ceremony and Global Citizen Festival; and
 - d) ground transportation to and from events hosted by Promoter, where the attendance of each Prize Winner is requested.

The approximate aggregate value of the expenses outlined in section 7 above is USD\$4,000 provided, however, that said value may change depending on, *inter alia*, Prize Winner's location, point of departure, and time of travel.
8. Promoter will not be liable for any costs, expenses, or consideration other than expressly outlined above, including, without limitation, costs for passports, any requisite visas, insurance, local transport to and from Prize Winner's departure point, additional transfers, items of a personal nature, in-room charges and all other ancillary costs. Each Prize Winner and their companion must depart from and return to the same departure point and travel together. Itineraries are to be determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion.

9. Prize Winners will be selected on or around July 8, 2019. Each Prize Winner will be contacted by email or phone within five (5) business days of selection and will be announced on the Promoter website on or around August 5, 2019
10. This Competition is a game of skill and as such, the Prize Winners are selected based on the criteria outlined by Promoter herein.
11. Prize Winners are advised that tax implications may arise from their prize winning and should seek independent financial advice prior to the acceptance of the Prize. Prizes will be paid to Prize Winners' designated organizations through wire transfer.
12. All Entrants grant Promoter the right to use said Entrant's name, city, and other information as contained in the entry application for publicity and Competition purposes and to generally promote the charitable endeavors and mission of Promoter, without compensation to Entrant.
13. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect, incidental, special consequential, exemplary or punitive damage or loss), regardless of the theory of liability (tort including negligence, contract, or otherwise), even if such damage or loss is foreseeable or Entrant has been advised of the possibility of such damages, including for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with the Competition or the Prize except for damages caused by Promoter's willful misconduct or gross negligence.
15. As a condition of accepting the Prize, each Prize Winner must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.
16. Each entrant's personal information ("PI") is collected to enable the Promoter to administer and promote this Competition and the Prize Winner. The PI of each Prize Winner may be provided to third parties who are assisting the Promoter, including prize suppliers, deliverers and authorities that regulate competitions. Entrants who fail to provide all requested PI, may be determined by the Promoter, at its sole discretion, to be ineligible to win a Prize. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The collection, use and disclosure of personal information provided in connection with this Competition is further governed by the the Promoter [Privacy Policy](#).
17. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, corruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of, entries. The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer networks and systems,

servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any e-mail or entry to be received by the Promoter on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination of them, including any injury or damage to any entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in this Competition.

18. All entries become the property of Promoter. As such, Promoter is the owner of all copyright and all other intellectual property in the Competition entries, and to the extent Promoter is not considered the owner, each Entrant hereby transfers and assigns all right and title in and to the information contained in the entries to the Promoter.
19. The Competition will be governed by the laws of the State of New York and subject to the jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts residing in New York County, New York.
20. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardize the fair and proper conduct of the Competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
21. If for any reason the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process or to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition.
22. In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result of the Competition or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same or materially similar conditions at a later date.
