



GLOBAL CITIZEN CURTIS SCHOLARSHIP

2018 Curtis Scholarship Award Terms and Conditions

1. The Promoter is Global Poverty Project, Inc d/b/a Global Citizen of 594 Broadway, Suite 207, NY NY 10012, United States of America (“Promoter”).
2. By entering the 2018 Curtis Scholarship Award (the “Competition”), entrants accept these Terms & Conditions of entry.
3. Entry to this Competition is open to individuals (“Entrants”) that:
 - A. are 16-20 years of age at time of submitting an application for the Competition)
 - B. are either a U.S. Citizens or U.K. Citizens
 - C. have limited past overseas travel
 - D. have a family household income of under \$85,000 USD or £60,000 GBP

If an Entrant is under the age of majority, then he/she must obtain prior consent from his/her parent or legal guardian to enter into this Competition and the parent or legal guardian may be required to verify the granting of consent and/or sign a release at the discretion of the Promoter. Failure of an Entrant’s parent or legal guardian to verify consent and/or sign a release will invalidate an Entrant’s application.

4. To enter the Competition, entrants must follow the instructions at <https://www.globalcitizen.org/en/programs/curtis-scholarship/>. Entries must be submitted between 3:00PM EDT on April 20, 2018 and 11:59PM EDT on May 20, 2018. Entrants will be graded out of 50 points in three areas: global citizenship, potential, passion/personality and commitment to social justice. Each Entrant will be scored twice by two different reviewers to gain a possible total of 100 points. The top 25 applicants will be reviewed in a second round until 12 finalists are chosen to be presented to Kelly Curtis, Hollywood Trust and the Promoter. 12 Finalists (6 U.S. citizens and 6 U.K. citizens) will be evaluated on individual merit, including the following three (3) key areas:
 - A. Global Citizenship - embodying and exemplifying the values and practices of a global citizen.
 - B. Potential - the amount the Award would scale up or improve the Entrant’s capabilities.
 - C. Passion - the Entrant’s dedication to social justice and advocacy.

5. The Award consists of:
 - A. Weekly pre-trip activities (June through August) and Monthly post-trip activities (September - December)
 - B. Round trip airfare to South Africa (August 2 - 12) and New York (September 24-29)
 - C. Global Citizen-led Orientation

7. Promoter will pay for the following for each Finalist:
 - A. One-way economy airfares to New York City for 6 U.S. Finalist for Orientation on August 1, 2018;
 - B. One-way economy transport to London for 6 U.K. finalist for Orientation on August 1;
 - C. Hotel accommodation in New York City and London for each Finalist for Orientation on August 1;
 - D. Return economy airfares to South Africa for 12 Finalists for 2-12 August 2018;
 - E. Hotel accommodation in South Africa for each Finalist for the period of 2-12 August 2018;
 - F. All trip-related meals for each Finalist during 2-12 August 2018 and during 24-29 September 2018;
 - G. hotel accommodation in New York City for Finalists for the period 24-29 September 2018;
 - H. All trip-related transportation in New York City (24-29 September 2018) and in South Africa (2-12 August 2018);
 - I. Insurance, passport fees and processing for all Finalists;
 - J. All other trip related expenses at the Promoter's discretion.

8. Promoter will not be liable for any expenses other than expressly outlined above, including, without limitation, items of a personal nature, in-room charges and all other ancillary costs. Each Finalist must depart from and return to the same departure point and travel together. Itineraries are to be determined by the Promoter in its absolute discretion.

9. Finalists will be selected at 594 Broadway, Suite 207, NY NY 10012 on or around May 31, 2018. Each Prize Winner will be contacted by email or phone within five (5) business days of selection and will be announced on the Promoter website by 4 June 2018.

10. This Competition is a game of skill and as such, the winners are selected based on the creativity of entries submitted.

12. All Entrants grant Promoter the right to use said Entrant's name, city, and other information as contained in the entry application for publicity and Competition purposes and to generally promote the charitable endeavors and mission of Promoter, without compensation.
13. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained in connection with the prize except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
15. As a condition of accepting the Award, each Finalist must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.
16. Each entrant's personal information ("PI") is collected to enable the Promoter to administer and promote this Competition and the Finalist. The PI of each Finalist may be provided to third parties who are assisting the Promoter, including award suppliers, deliverers and authorities that regulate competitions. Entrants who fail to provide all requested PI, may be determined by the Promoter, at its sole discretion, to be ineligible to win the Award. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The collection, use and disclosure of personal information provided in connection with this promotion is further governed by the the Promoter [Privacy Policy](#).
17. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, corruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorised access to, or alteration of, entries. The Promoter is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer networks and systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment, software, failure of any e-mail or entry to be received by the Promoter on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any web site, or any combination of them, including any injury or damage to any entrant's or any other person's computer related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in this Competition.
18. All entries become the property of Promoter. As such, Promoter is the owner of all copyright and all other intellectual property in the Competition entries, and to the extent Promoter is not considered the owner, each Entrant hereby transfers and assigns all right and title in and to the information contained in the entries.
19. The Competition will be governed by the laws of the State of New York and subject to the jurisdiction and venue of the state and federal courts residing in New York County, New York.

20. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these conditions, or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardize the fair and proper conduct of the competition. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
21. If for any reason the competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process or to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
22. In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions at a later date.
